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Berkely Road Update

Dear Resident

I have been advised by the Chair of the Traffic and Transport Committee, Dublin City Council, that the council is due to vote on the Croke Park bye-laws on **2nd November 2009**.

The provisions of the bye-laws include:

- That a car cannot be not be parked within the Restricted Area during the Restricted Period unless a **Parking Permit** (Major Event Permit/Major Event Visitor's Parking Permit / Resident's Parking Permit/ Visitor's Parking Permit) for the vehicle is displayed upon the vehicle. "Restricted period" means one hour before and one hour after the scheduled finish time of the event.
- **"Major Event"** means the following events:
All Ireland Senior Football Finals, Semi Finals, and Quarter Finals.
All Ireland Senior Hurling Finals, Semi Finals and Quarter Finals.
All international soccer and professional rugby matches played at Croke Park.
All concerts at Croke Park for which are licensed by Dublin City Council.
- Each household can receive one visitor permit per household.
- It is now proposed that 'pay and display' bays would be exempt from the bye-laws to allow access to hospitals, churches and businesses.
- The scheme would cost €200,000 to set up and €85,000 a year to operate.
