## Pay and Display Permit Parking Double Yello Lines

Dear Resident,

On 24<sup>th</sup> February last, on foot of a resident's request, I contacted Dublin City Council officials to request that Ben Edair road be assessed for pay and display parking. This was particularly in light of Oxmantown Road's recent ballot for pay and display, and concerns regarding the displacement this might cause.

I have just been advised by the Traffic Advisory Committee of Dublin City Council that **Pay & Display/Permit Parking has been recommended at Ben Edair Road, subject to the agreement of residents, as follows:**

- Westside from a point 5m north of Halliday Road north for 69m (approx 14 spaces).
- Westside from a point 5m north of Moira Road, north for 84m (approx 17 spaces).
- Eastside from a point 5m north of Halliday Road, north for 182m (approx 36 spaces).

### Double Yellow Lines

- 5m each side of the junction of Ben Edair and Halliday Road.
- 5m each side of the junction of Ben Edair and Moira Road.
- 5m each side of the southern corner of the junction of Ben Edair and Godfrey Place.

Residents will be asked to vote on the above suggestions. I am advised that that balloting will take place in the next two or three months. If the majority of those who vote are in favour of the above proposals, it takes about another month before the scheme commences. during which there is liaison with gardai and engineers
